A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO COLLABORATE WITH
 THE NORTH CAROLINA PREVENTION PARTNERS AND LOCAL RESTAURANT
 ASSOCIATIONS TO ENCOURAGE NUTRITIONAL AND CALORIC MENU
 LABELING IN RESTAURANTS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA
 TASK FORCE ON PREVENTING CHILDHOOD OBESITY.
- 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 SECTION 1. By February 1, 2010, the Department of Health and Human Services, 9 Division of Public Health, in collaboration with the North Carolina Prevention Partners, the North Carolina Restaurant and Lodging Association, and other restaurant organizations in this 10 State, shall develop and submit a plan to the General Assembly to encourage restaurant owners 11 12 to make nutrition and calorie information about menu items readily available to consumers in restaurants. The plan shall include an explanation of (i) the specific types of restaurants that 13 will be encouraged to provide nutrition and calorie information to consumers, (ii) the specific 14 nutrition and calorie information that restaurants will be encouraged to provide to consumers, 15 and (iii) the technical assistance the Division of Public Health will provide to restaurant 16 17 owners, at their request, regarding how to prominently display nutrition and calorie information about menu items for consumers in restaurants. 18

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SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.



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
