2	AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW DEATH BY MOTOR VEHICLE CHARGE WHEN THE	
3	DEATH IS THE RESULT OF THE OPERATION OF A COMMERCIAL MOTOR	
4	VEHICLE BY AN OWNER-OPERATOR WHO KNEW THE COMMERCIAL MOTOR	
5	VEHICLE WAS NOT SAFE FOR OPERATION.	
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-141.4(a1) reads as rewritten:	
8	"(a1) Felony Death by Vehicle A person commits the offense of felony death by	
9	vehicle if:	
10	(1) The person unintentionally causes the death of another person,	
11	(2) The person was engaged in the offense of impaired driving under	
12	G.S. 20-138.1 or G.S. 20-138.2, or the person was the owner-operator of a	
13	commercial motor vehicle and knew, or should have known, that the	
14	commercial motor vehicle being operated at the time of the death was not in	
15	compliance with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations contained in	
16	Title 49, Subchapter B, of the Code of Federal Regulations, and	
17	(3) The commission of the offense in subdivision (2) of this subsection is the	
18	proximate cause of the death."	
19	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to	
20	offenses committed on or after that date.	



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
