SI	ECTION 1. Article 8 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
a new section	to read:

- 7 "§ 14-34.10. Felonious affray with the use of a deadly weapon resulting in death or 8 serious bodily injury.

  9 (a) A person who engages in an affray in which a deadly weapon is used, resulting in
  - (a) A person who engages in an affray in which a deadly weapon is used, resulting in the death of another, shall be guilty of a Class C felony.
  - (b) A person who engages in an affray in which a deadly weapon is used, resulting in the serious bodily injury of another, shall be guilty of a Class E felony."
    - **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
