April 9, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF FELONIOUS AFFRAY WITH THE USE OF A DEADLY WEAPON RESULTING IN DEATH OR SERIOUS BODILY INJURY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 8 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-34.10. Felonious affray with the use of a deadly weapon resulting in death or serious bodily injury. A person who engages in an affray in which a deadly weapon is used, resulting in (a) the death of another, shall be guilty of a Class C felony. A person who engages in an affray in which a deadly weapon is used, resulting in

the serious bodily injury of another, shall be guilty of a Class E felony." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
