It is unlawful to engage in a commercial fishing operation, as defined in G.S. 113-168, with the use of commercial fishing equipment or gear within 500 yards of an area designated as an oyster sanctuary by the Marine Fisheries Commission. Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
