The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 16 of Chapter 113 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 113-211. Protection of oyster sanctuaries. It is unlawful to engage in a commercial fishing operation, as defined in G.S. 113-168, with the use of commercial fishing equipment or gear within 500 yards of an area designated as an

oyster sanctuary by the Marine Fisheries Commission. Any person who violates this section
