2	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS ON PUBLIC HIGHWAYS.
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-4.01 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
5	"(41b) Skateboard. – A human-powered device, with at least two tandem wheels in
6	contact with the ground and a deck on which a person may ride, designed to
7	transport one or more persons by pushing against the ground with the foot."
8	SECTION 2. Part 10 of Article 3 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended
9	by adding a new section to read:
10	"§ 20-171A. Skateboards on highways prohibited.
11	(a) No person shall operate a skateboard on a public highway. Violation of this
12	subsection by a person 16 years of age or older shall be an infraction.
13	(b) No parent or legal guardian of a person below the age of 16 shall knowingly permit
14	that person to operate a skateboard on a public highway. Violation of this subsection shall be an
15	infraction but shall not be a moving violation.

(c) No negligence or liability shall be assessed on or imputed to any party on account of a violation of subsection (a) or (b) of this section.

- (d) No points authorized by G.S. 20-16(c), nor insurance points as authorized by G.S. 58-36-65, shall be assigned to the operator of the skateboard."
- **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
