1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO DEFINE "COORDINATION" FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING 3 WHETHER AN IN-KIND CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION HAS OCCURRED. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 163-278.6 is amended to add a new subdivision to read: "(6a) The term "coordination" means, with respect to a disbursement or 6 expenditure, the act of making the disbursement or expenditure in 7 consultation with, at the request of, or at the suggestion of a candidate, 8 candidate's committee, or any agent of the candidate or candidate committee. 9 It shall constitute "coordination" when a candidate, candidate's committee, 10 or an agent of a candidate or candidate's committee was involved in 11 discussions with the person or entity making the disbursement or 12 expenditure regarding either of the following: 13 The content, intended audience, means or mode of communication, 14 specific media outlets, timing, frequency, size, prominence, or 15 duration of the communications funded by the disbursement or 16 expenditure. 17 18 The candidate's needs or plans. The term "coordination" shall not apply to the items enumerated in 19 20 G.S. 163-278.100(2)." **SECTION 2.** G.S. 163-278.6(9a) reads as rewritten: 21 The term "independently expend" or "independent expenditure" means an 22 expenditure to support or oppose the nomination or election of one or more 23 clearly identified candidates that is made without consultation or 24 25 coordination with a candidate or agent of a candidate whose nomination or election the expenditure supports or whose opponent's nomination or 26 27 election the expenditure opposes. Supporting or opposing the election of 28 clearly identified candidates includes supporting or opposing the candidates of a clearly identified political party. A contribution is not an independent 29 expenditure. As applied to referenda, the term "independent expenditure" 30 applies if consultation or coordination does not take place with a referendum 31 committee that supports a ballot measure the expenditure supports, or a 32



opposes."
