- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 6 SECTION 1. G.S. 14-313 is amended
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-313 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 "(e1) Smoking or otherwise consuming tobacco products by persons less than 18 years
 8 old. - It is unlawful for any person who is less than 18 years old to smoke or otherwise
 9 consume a tobacco product. Any person who violates this section is guilty of an infraction."

10 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
