AN ACT TO ALLOW COUNTIES TO LIMIT THE TAKING OF DEER WITH THE AID OFDOGS.

- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Article 6 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by 6 adding a new section to read:

7 "<u>§ 153A-129.1. Taking of deer with dogs.</u>

A county may by ordinance regulate the taking of deer with dogs. Notwithstanding the
provisions of G.S. 153A-122, an ordinance enacted under the authority of this section shall
apply throughout the county. An ordinance enacted under the authority of this section shall
supersede any conflicting local act applying to the county to the extent of the conflict but may
not have the effect of permitting activity with respect to hunting deer with dogs that is
prohibited or more severely restricted by regulations of the Wildlife Resources Commission."
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
