AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL TO USE TO SUPPORT THE CAROLINA COLLEGE ADVISING CORPS AND CAROLINA STUDENT TRANSFER EXCELLENCE PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million one hundred sixteen thousand seven hundred dollars (\$1,116,700) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year to be allocated to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to use to support the Carolina College Advising Corps (CCAC) and the Carolina Student Transfer Excellence Program (C-STEP). These programs aim to increase the college-going rate in North Carolina, with the CCAC focused on support for high school applicants in underserved communities and the C-STEP program focused on prospective transfer students from community colleges.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
