3 REQUIREMENTS WHEN LETTING CONTRACTS FOR USE AS PART OF 4 MUNICIPAL PILOT PROGRAMS AIMED AT INCREASING ENERGY EFFICIENCY, 5 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CARRBORO TO ENTER INTO A LEASE FOR 6 THE SITING AND OPERATION OF A RENEWABLE ENERGY FACILITY FOR 7 TWENTY YEARS WITHOUT TREATING IT AS A SALE AND WITHOUT GIVING 8 NOTICE BY PUBLICATION. 9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 10 SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2007-333, as rewritten by Section 1 of S.L. 11 2009-149, reads as rewritten: 12 "SECTION 1.(a) The City of Raleigh A municipality may contract for apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment that will be used as part of any pilot program authorized by the City 13 Council-its governing board aimed at increasing energy efficiency without being subject to the 14 requirements of G.S. 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132. Notwithstanding any provision of law, 15 the City-municipality may award a contract under this section in its sole discretion. 16 17 "SECTION 1.(b) This section applies to the City of Raleigh and the Town of Carrboro only." 18 19 **SECTION 2.** Section 3 of S.L. 2009-149 reads as rewritten: 20 "SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act applies to the City-Cities of Raleigh and the City of Winston-Salem and the Town of Carrboro only." 21 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 22
