A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT EXEMPTING THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING  
2 REQUIREMENTS WHEN LETTING CONTRACTS FOR USE AS PART OF  
3 MUNICIPAL PILOT PROGRAMS AIMED AT INCREASING ENERGY EFFICIENCY,  
4 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO ENTER INTO A LEASE  
5 FOR THE SITING AND OPERATION OF A RENEWABLE ENERGY FACILITY FOR  
6 TWENTY YEARS WITHOUT TREATING IT AS A SALE AND WITHOUT GIVING  
7 NOTICE BY PUBLICATION.

9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

10 **SECTION 1.** Section 1 of S.L. 2007-333, as rewritten by Section 1 of S.L.  
11 2009-149, reads as rewritten:

12 "**SECTION 1.(a)** ~~The City of Raleigh~~ A municipality may contract for apparatus, supplies,  
13 materials, or equipment that will be used as part of any pilot program authorized by ~~the City~~  
14 ~~Council~~ its governing board aimed at increasing energy efficiency without being subject to the  
15 requirements of G.S. 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132. Notwithstanding any provision of law,  
16 the ~~City~~ municipality may award a contract under this section in its sole discretion.

17 "**SECTION 1.(b)** This section applies to the City of Raleigh and the Town of Chapel Hill  
18 only."

19 **SECTION 2.** Section 3 of S.L. 2009-149 reads as rewritten:

20 "**SECTION 3.** Section 2 of this act applies to the ~~City~~ Cities of Raleigh and ~~the City of~~  
21 Winston-Salem and the Town of Chapel Hill only."

22 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
