13	materials, or equipment that will be used as part of any pilot program authorized by the City		
14	Council its governing board aimed at increasing energy efficiency without being subject to the		
15	requirements of G.S. 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132. Notwithstanding any provision of law,		
16	•	icipality may award a contract under this section in its sole discretion.	1 7 7 1 1
