Short Title: Special Plate - Silver Star/Disabled Veteran. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Holloway; Dockham, Faison, Gulley, Harrison, Hughes, Killian, Lucas, McElraft, Moore, and Tarleton. Referred to: Transportation, if favorable, Finance. May 26, 2010 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE A SILVER STAR AWARD/DISABLED VETERAN SPECIAL PLATE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten: Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates: "(b) (129a) Silver Star Recipient/Disabled Veteran. – Issuable to a recipient of the Silver Star who is also a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States who suffered a one hundred percent (100%) service-connected disability. The plate shall bear the emblem of the Silver Star laid over the universal symbol for the handicapped and the words "Silver Star." For the purposes of a fee for this plate, it shall be treated as a one hundred percent (100%) Disabled Veteran plate.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
