1 **SECTION 3.** If a majority of votes cast on the question are in favor of the 2 amendment set out in Section 1 of this act, the State Board of Elections shall certify the 3 amendment to the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State shall enroll the amendment so 4 certified among the permanent records of that office.

5 **SECTION 4.** The amendment set out in Section 1 of this act becomes effective 6 July 1, 2011, and applies beginning with the first fiscal period beginning on or after that date. 7 The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
