"(b) E	xempt persons and activities. – This Article does not apply to any of the following
persons or ac	tivities:

Chapter 87 of the General Statutes, a professional engineer under Chapter 89C of the General Statutes, a geologist under Chapter 89E of the General Statutes, or a soil scientist under Chapter 89F of the General Statutes who uses a hand auger to collect soil or water samples or to measure water levels. This exemption does not include the construction of a monitoring well." 

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
