8	SECTION 1. G.S. 105-113.5 reads as rewritten:

10	A tax is levied on the sale or possession for sale in this State, by a distributor, of all

A tax is levied on the sale or possession for sale in this State, by a distributor, of all cigarettes at the rate of one and three fourths cents (1.75ϕ) five and ninety-five hundredths cents (5.95ϕ) per individual cigarette. The Secretary shall credit the net proceeds collected under this Part as follows:

- 14 (1) Seventy percent (70%) to the Trust Fund for Mental Health, Developmental
 15 Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services and Bridge Funding Needs
 16 established under G.S. 143C-9-2.
- 17 (2) Thirty percent (30%) to the General Fund."
 18 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
