The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-301(a) reads as rewritten:	
"(a) On-Street Parking A city may by ordinance regulate, restrict, and p	rohibit the
parking of vehicles on the public streets, alleys, and bridges within the city. When	parking is
permitted for a specified period of time at a particular location, a city may install	
meter at that location and require any person parking a vehicle therein to place th	e meter in
operation for the entire time that the vehicle remains in that location, up to the maxi-	
allowed for parking there. Parking meters may be activated by coins or tokens.coin	
credit cards, or electronic means. A city may establish parking zones within the cit	-

the zone in which the meter is located. Proceeds from the use of parking meters

SECTION 2. This act applies to the Cities of Raleigh and Wilmington and the Towns of Chapel Hill, Wrightsville Beach, Carolina Beach, and Kure Beach only.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
