A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO DESIGNATE
THAT PORTION OF U.S. HIGHWAY 441 BETWEEN CHEROKEE, NORTH
CAROLINA, AND THE NORTH CAROLINA-TENNESSEE STATE LINE A SCENIC
BYWAY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Subject to the provisions of G.S. 136-18(31), the Department of
Transportation shall designate that portion of U.S. Highway 441 between the Qualla Boundary
of the Eastern Band of Cherokee's Reservation, in Cherokee, North Carolina, and the North
Carolina-Tennessee State Line, at Clingman's Dome, as a Scenic Byway.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
