## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIVIDE PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 20A INTO DISTRICTS 20A AND 20E.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

**SECTION 2.** The district attorney position established for District 20A by Section 1 of this act shall be filled by the district attorney currently serving District 20A who resides in Richmond County. That district attorney's term expires December 31, 2014, and a successor shall be elected in the 2014 election.

**SECTION 3.** The district attorney position established for District 20E by Section 1 of this act shall be filled by election in the 2010 election for a four-year term commencing January 1, 2011.

**SECTION 4.** The seven assistant district attorney positions established for District 20A by Section 1 of this act shall be filled by seven assistant district attorneys currently serving Anson and Richmond Counties in District 20A. The five assistant district attorney positions established for District 20E by Section 1 of this act shall be filled by five assistant district attorneys currently serving Stanly County in District 20A.

**SECTION 5.** G.S. 7A-69 reads as rewritten:

## "§ 7A-69. Investigatorial assistants.

 The district attorney in prosecutorial districts 1, 3B, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15A, 15B, 16A, 18, 19B, 20A, 20B, <u>20E</u>, 21, 22A, 22B, 24, 25, 26, 27A, 27B, 28, 29A, 29B, and 30 is entitled to one investigatorial assistant, and the district attorney in prosecutorial district 10 is entitled to two investigatorial assistants, to be appointed by the district attorney and to serve at his pleasure.
