4	4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5		<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-140.4(a) reads as rewritten:		
6	"(a)	No person shall operate a motorcycle or moped upon a highway or public vehicular		
7	area:			
8		(1) When the number of persons upon such motorcycle or moped, including the		
9		operator, shall exceed the number of persons which it was designed to carry.		
10		(2) Unless the operator and all passengers thereon wear on their heads, with a		
11		retention strap properly secured, safety helmets of a type that complies with		
12		Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 218.		
13		(3) With a passenger who is under the age of 16 years."		
14		<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to offenses		
15	committed on or after that date.
