A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE REQUIRED SCHOOL OPENING AND CLOSING DATES IN THE ELKIN CITY, MOUNT AIRY CITY, AND SURRY COUNTY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:

7 Opening and Closing Dates. - Local boards of education shall determine the dates "(d) 8 of opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for 9 year-round schools, the opening date for students shall not be before August 25, and the more 10 than five days prior to the starting date of the fall term at Surry Community College, as 11 established by its board of trustees. The closing date for students shall not be after June 10. On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive this requirement to the 12 extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipated 13 14 makeup days due to school closings. A local board may revise the scheduled closing date if 15 necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional days or 16 instructional time. For purposes of this subsection, the term "good cause" means that schools in 17 any local school administrative unit in a county have been closed eight days per year during 18 any four of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power 19 failures, or other emergency situations.

20 The State Board also may waive this requirement for an educational purpose. The term "educational purpose" means a local school administrative unit establishes a need to adopt a 21 22 different calendar for (i) a specific school to accommodate a special program offered generally 23 to the student body of that school, (ii) a school that primarily serves a special population of 24 students, or (iii) a defined program within a school. The State Board may grant the waiver for 25 an educational purpose for that specific school or defined program to the extent that the State Board finds that the educational purpose is reasonable, the accommodation is necessary to 26 27 accomplish the educational purpose, and the request is not an attempt to circumvent the 28 opening and closing dates set forth in this subsection. The waiver requests for educational 29 purposes shall not be used to accommodate system-wide class scheduling preferences.

The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school that a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to any school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of modified calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."

34 SECTION 2. This act applies only to the Elkin City, Mount Airy City, and Surry
35 County School Administrative Units.



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SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and expires July 1, 2015.
