A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT ALLOWING THE TOWN OF BURGAW TO EXERCISE EXTRATERRITORIAL 3 JURISDICTION OVER AN AREA EXTENDING TWO MILES FROM ITS LIMITS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the population provisions in G.S. 160A-360(a), the Town of Burgaw may exercise the extraterritorial jurisdiction powers granted in Article 19 of 6 Chapter 160A of the General Statutes within a defined area extending not more than two miles 7 beyond its corporate limits. Except as otherwise provided by this act, the extension of 8 9 extraterritorial jurisdiction by the Town of Burgaw is subject to the provisions of 10 G.S. 160A-360. 11

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
