2	AN ACT TO ALLOW THE USE OF GOLF CARTS IN THE COMMUNITY OF DEEP RUN.	
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-54, a	
5	person may operate a golf cart on any public street or highway within the area west of N.C.	
6	Highway 11 to the west, Southwest Creek to the north, the intersection of John Green Smith	
7	Road to the east, and the intersection of Old N.C. Highway 11 and the N.C. Highway 11	
8	Bypass to the south.	
9	<b>SECTION 2.</b> No person shall operate a golf cart within the area defined in Section	
10	1 of this act while being less than 16 years of age or at night.	
11	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act applies to the community of Deep Run in Lenoir County	
12	only.	
13	<b>SECTION 4.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to offenses	
14	committed on or after that date.
