A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT JUDGE
FOR DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 19A.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

30 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge for
 31 District 19A authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the 2010
 32 election for a four-year term commencing January 1, 2011.

33 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
 34 Department the sum of eighty-four thousand three hundred sixty-three dollars (\$84,363) for the
 35 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty thousand one hundred eight dollars
 36 (\$150,108) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to fund the additional district court judgeship
 37 authorized by this act.

38 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2010.
