March 31, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO LIMIT TO ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS A BUDGET PROVISION GRANTING IN-STATE TUITION TO CERTAIN FULL SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 116-143.6(b) reads as rewritten: "(b) The following definitions apply in this section: "Full cost" means an amount calculated by the constituent institution that is no less than the sum of tuition, required fees, and on-campus room and

SECTION 2. The amendment of G.S. 116-143.6 by Section 1 of this act does not affect the receipt of full scholarships for the 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 academic years by persons who received the scholarships prior to the amendment.

"Full scholarship" means a grant based on academic merit that meets the full cost for a student to attend the constituent institution for an academic year."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
