A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CLINTON TO GIVE ANNUAL NOTICE TO CHRONIC VIOLATORS OF THE CITY'S OVERGROWN VEGETATION ORDINANCE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-200(b) reads as rewritten: "(b) This section applies to the Towns of Ahoskie, Ayden, Franklinton, Leland, Marshville, Pinetops, Pineville, Smithfield, Spring Lake, Wingate, and Yadkinville, and to the Cities of <u>Clinton</u> , Durham, Eden, Gastonia, Greensboro, High Point, Lexington, Louisburg, Monroe, Mount Airy, Reidsville, Roanoke Rapids, Rockingham, Rocky Mount, Wadesboro, and Winston-Salem only." SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
