SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study North Carolina child support guidelines regarding child support arrearage that does not accrue for a parent who is incarcerated, including the impact the lack of arrearage accrual has on the non-incarcerated parent.

SECTION 2. The Commission shall submit a final report of its findings and recommendations to the 2010 Regular Session of the 2009 General Assembly by filing the report with the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
