1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE HISTORIC BARKER HOUSE IN
3 EDENTON.
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Edenton
6 Historical Commission the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2009-2010
7 fiscal year for repairs at the historic Barker House in Edenton, which served as the home of
8 Penelope Barker, a prominent figure in the 1774 Edenton Tea Party.
9 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
