1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE HISTORIC BARKER HOUSE IN 2 3 EDENTON. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Edenton 5 SECTION 1. Historical Commission the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2009-2010 6 7 fiscal year for repairs at the historic Barker House in Edenton, which served as the home of 8 Penelope Barker, a prominent figure in the 1774 Edenton Tea Party. 9 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
