A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE COMMUNITY COLLEGES TO TEACH DEVELOPMENTAL 3 COURSES AND COLLEGE SUCCESS SKILLS COURSES AT ANY TIME DURING 4 THE YEAR, INCLUDING THE SUMMER TERM, AND TO EARN BUDGET FTE FOR 5 THE COURSES. 6 Whereas, approximately 25% of the new jobs created in North Carolina over the

7 next 10 years will require at least a four-year college degree, and an additional 13% are 8 predicted to require an associate degree; and

9 Whereas, only 19% of entering ninth graders in North Carolina complete high school and college within 150% of program time; and 10

Whereas, 64% of 2008 North Carolina high school graduates who enrolled at 11 community colleges required remediation in the form of one or more developmental classes 12 before beginning college-level work at a North Carolina community college; and 13

14 Whereas, having to take remediation greatly reduces the likelihood that students will 15 complete college programs on time as well as overall success rates; and

16 Whereas, students requiring remediation could get a jump start and improve the 17 likelihood of program completion by taking those classes in the summer prior to enrolling in college-level courses; and 18

19 Whereas, since the 2001-2002 recession year, community colleges have not been 20 funded to provide summer school classes; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 21

SECTION 1. G.S. 115D-5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

- Community colleges may teach developmental courses and college success skills 23 "(u) 24 courses at any time during the year, including the summer term. Membership hours produced 25 from these courses shall be counted when computing full-time equivalent students (FTE) for
- use in budget funding formulas at the State level." 26 27

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
