5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 96-8(10) is amended by adding a new sub-subdivision to read:
7	"f. No substitute teacher or other substitute school personnel shall be
8	considered unemployed for days or weeks when not called to work
9	unless the individual is or was employed as a full-time substitute
10	during the period of time for which the individual is requesting
11	benefits. For the purposes of this subsection, full-time substitute is
12	defined as a substitute employee who works more than 30 hours a
13	week on a continual basis for a period of six months or more."
14	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 96-8(6)k.21. is repealed.
15	<b>SECTION 3.</b> G.S. 96-8(6)k.22. is repealed.
16	<b>SECTION 4.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
