17		activities and services are achieving desired results.			
18	(3)	To develop unit cost measures to determine the cost of activities performed			
19		and services provided by a State agency.			
20	(4)	To determine if a program or an activity of a State agency complies with the			
21		agency's mission, as established by law.			
22	(5)	To make unannounced visits to a State agency when needed to evaluate a			
23		program or an activity of the agency.

26	(7)	To determine the extent to which a State agency has implemented any of the			
27		Division's recommendations concerning the agency.

32	(9)	To make periodic reports of the activities and recommendations of the			
33		Division and of any savings achieved by the implementation of its

6		G.S. 120-131.
7	<u>(11)</u>	To conduct and update an inventory of State programs that are aimed at
8		reducing or alleviating the condition of poverty, to evaluate the outcomes
9		and effectiveness of those programs, and to write and update a history of
10		State efforts to reduce poverty."
