

## **General Assembly of North Carolina**

1 **SECTION 2.** The Department of Public Instruction and the Department of Health 2 and Human Services shall cooperate in the development of curricula to implement Section 1 of 3 this act.

4 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 1 of this act shall 5 be implemented by the beginning of the 2012-2013 school year.
