13			tax system that would increase, decrease, or redistribute tax by more than
14			twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000). In a report required by this
15			subdivision, the report shall present information on the distribution of the tax
16			burden for the overall income distribution, using a systemwide incidence
17			measure that appropriately measures equality and inequality, and by income
18			classes broken down by quintiles. A report required by this subdivision shall
