4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 105-277.1C(a), as enacted by S.L. 2008-107, reads as rewritten:
6	"(a) Exclusion A permanent residence owned and occupied by an owner who is a
7	North Carolina resident and who is an honorably discharged disabled veteran or the unmarried
8	surviving spouse of an honorably discharged disabled veteran is designated a special class of
9	property under Article V, Section 2(2) of the North Carolina Constitution and is taxable in
10	accordance with this section. The first forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000)sixty-five thousand
11	dollars (\$65,000) of appraised value of the residence is excluded from taxation. An owner who
12	receives an exclusion under this section may not receive other property tax relief."
13	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after July 1,
