5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2008-209 is repealed.
7	SECTION 2. Section 3 of S.L. 2008-209 reads as rewritten:
8	"SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes law.
9	Section 2 expires at the same time that the amendment to G.S. 115C-302.1(d) made by House
10	Bill 2436, 2007 Regular Session, expires."
11	SECTION 3. Section 26.21(b) of S.L. 2008-107 is repealed.
12	SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
13	Public Instruction the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year
14	and the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to implement this
15	act.
16	SECTION 5. Section 4 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2009. The remainder
17	of this act becomes effective June 30, 2009.
