1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO REPEAL THE FIFTY-DOLLAR SURCHARGE ON ATTORNEY
3	MEMBERSHIP FEES FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA PUBLIC CAMPAIGN FUND.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 163-278.63(b)(7) is repealed.
6	SECTION 2. G.S. 84-34 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 84-34. Membership fees and list of members.
8	Every active member of the North Carolina State Bar shall, prior to the first day of July of
9 10	each year, pay to the secretary-treasurer an annual membership fee in an amount determined by the Council but not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300.00), plus a surcharge of fifty dollars
11	(\$50.00) for the implementation of Article 22D of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes, and
12	every member shall notify the secretary-treasurer of the member's correct mailing address. Any
13	member who fails to pay the required dues by the last day of June of each year shall be subject
14	to a late fee in an amount determined by the Council but not to exceed thirty dollars (\$30.00).
15	All dues for prior years shall be as were set forth in the General Statutes then in effect. The
16	membership fee shall be regarded as a service charge for the maintenance of the several
17	services authorized by this Article, and shall be in addition to all fees required in connection
18	with admissions to practice, and in addition to all license taxes required by law. The fee shall
19	not be prorated: Provided, that no fee shall be required of an attorney licensed after this Article
20	shall have gone into effect until the first day of January of the calendar year following that in
21 22	which the attorney was licensed; but this proviso shall not apply to attorneys from other states admitted on certificate. The fees shall be disbursed by the secretary-treasurer on the order of the
22	Council. The fifty-dollar (\$50.00) surcharge shall be sent on a monthly schedule to the State
24	Board of Elections. The secretary-treasurer shall annually, at a time and in a law magazine or
25	daily newspaper to be prescribed by the Council, publish an account of the financial
26	transactions of the Council in a form to be prescribed by it. The secretary-treasurer shall
27	compile and keep currently correct from the names and mailing addresses forwarded to the
28	secretary-treasurer and from any other available sources of information a list of members of the
29	North Carolina State Bar and furnish to the clerk of the superior court in each county, not later
30	than the first day of October in each year, a list showing the name and address of each attorney
31	for that county who has not complied with the provisions of this Article. The name of each of
32 33	the active members who are in arrears in the payment of membership fees shall be furnished to the presiding judge at the payt term of the superior court after the first day of October of each
55 34	the presiding judge at the next term of the superior court after the first day of October of each year, by the clerk of the superior court of each county wherein the member or members reside,
34	and the court shall thereupon take action that is necessary and proper. The names and addresses
36	of attorneys so certified shall be kept available to the public. The Secretary of Revenue is
37	hereby directed to supply the secretary-treasurer, from records of license tax payments, with



1 any information for which the secretary-treasurer may call in order to enable the 2 secretary-treasurer to comply with this requirement.

3 The list submitted to several clerks of the superior court shall also be submitted to the

4 Council at its October meeting of each year and it shall take the action thereon that is necessary5 and proper."

6 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2010, and applies to 7 membership fees due for 2010.
