| 7 | "Sec. 4.21. City Attorney; Appointment, Compensation, Powers, and Duties. Powers | |
| 8 | and Duties of the City Attorney. | |
| 9 | (a) The city council shall appoint the city attorney who shall hold office at the pleasure | |
| 10 | of the city council and shall receive such compensation as it may fix. | |
| 11 | (b) The city attorney shall (1) serve as legal advisor to the city council, the city manager | |
| 12 | and all city departments, officers and agencies; (2) represent as counsel the city, its officers, | |
| 13 | agents, or employees, in any legal action arising out of or connected with the proper functions | |
| 14 | of the city, its officers, agents, or employees, unless disqualified to so act; (3) approve as to | |
| 15 | form all ordinances and resolutions, including initiated or referred ordinances, prior to their | |
| 16 | introduction." | |
| 17 | SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. | |
