7	"Sec. 4.21. City Attorney; Appointment, Compensation, Powers, and Duties. Powers		
8	and Duties of the City Attorney.		
9	(a) The city council shall appoint the city attorney who shall hold office at the pleasure		
10	of the city council and shall receive such compensation as it may fix.		
11		he city attorney shall (1) serve as legal advisor to the city council, the city r	•
12		lepartments, officers and agencies; (2) represent as counsel the city, its of	
13	agents, or em	ployees, in any legal action arising out of or connected with the proper fu	inctions
14	of the city, it	ts officers, agents, or employees, unless disqualified to so act; (3) approv	e as to
15	form all ordinances and resolutions, including initiated or referred ordinances, prior to their		
16	introduction.'
