SECTION 2. The State Board of Community Colleges shall review the purchasing process for community colleges and shall consider whether the State Board of Community Colleges should have the authority to increase the bid value benchmark for each community college based on the college's overall capabilities, including staff resources, purchasing compliance reviews, and audit reports.

The State Board of Community Colleges shall report the results of its study to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee prior to March 30, 2010.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
