A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING NEW HANOVER COUNTY TO PROVIDE DEVELOPMENT
INCENTIVES IN EXCHANGE FOR REDUCTIONS IN ENERGY CONSUMPTION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of S.L. 2007-241, as amended by S.L. 2008-22, reads as
rewritten:

"SECTION 2. This act applies only to ~~Cabarrus County~~, the Counties of Cabarrus and
New Hanover, to the Cities of Asheville, Charlotte, Concord, Durham, Kannapolis, Locust, and
Wilmington, and to the Towns of Carrboro, Cary, Chapel Hill, Harrisburg, Midland, Mount
Pleasant, and Stanfield."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
