1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INDUSTRIAL 3 DEVELOPMENT FUND. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. G.S. 143B-437.01 reads as rewritten: 6 "§ 143B-437.01. Industrial Development Fund. 7 Creation and Purpose of Fund. - There is created in the Department of Commerce (a) 8 the Industrial Development Fund to provide funds to assist the local government units of the most economically distressed counties in the State in creating jobs in certain industries. The 9 Department of Commerce shall adopt rules providing for the administration of the program. 10 11 Those rules shall include the following provisions, which shall apply to each grant from the 12 fund: 13 14 (2)The funds shall be used by the city and county governments for projects that will directly result in the creation of new jobs.
