6	SECTION 1. G.S. 105-164.13 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"§ 105-164.13. Retail sales and use tax.
8	The sale at retail and the use, storage, or consumption in this State of the following tangible
9	personal property and services are specifically exempted from the tax imposed by this Article:

11	(60) Liquefied petroleum gas when sold to an individual purchaser for domestic
12	consumption. Domestic consumption does not include use or consumption
13	for business, commercial, or industrial purposes."
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and applies to deliveries
15	made on or after that date.
