A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT FOLKMOOT USA'S COMMUNITY INTERNATIONAL ARTS AND CULTURAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

Whereas, Folkmoot USA, North Carolina's official International Festival, is a two-week celebration of the world's cultural heritage through folk music and dance; and

Whereas, Folkmoot USA is held for two weeks each summer across the beautiful mountains of Western North Carolina; and

Whereas, Folkmoot USA holds over 25 events each year in over eight different counties; and

Whereas, Folkmoot USA features performances, parades, and workshops by more than 350 performers from a dozen or so countries; and

Whereas, during its 26-year history, over 200 folk groups from more than 100 countries from all over the globe have shared their heritage and culture at Folkmoot USA; and

Whereas, Folkmoot USA continues to have a positive fiscal impact in western North Carolina; and

Whereas, in 2007 Folkmoot USA contributed \$4,026,684 to the local economy, which included a direct impact in terms of payroll expenditures, other operating expenditures, and attendee spending of \$2,828,486 and indirect and induced effects of these same categories of \$526,907 and \$607,290, respectively; and

Whereas, Folkmoot USA also created and maintained 56.6 jobs during that same year; and

Whereas, Folkmoot USA is the largest event of the International Council of Organizations for Folklore Festivals and Folk Art (CIOFF) sponsored events in the United States; and

Whereas, Folkmoot USA's contributions to the cultural life of the community and the enhancement of the region's reputation make it a tourism destination; and

Whereas, Folkmoot USA has been cited by the Southeast Tourism Society as one of the top 20 events in the Southeast United States; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Folkmoot USA, a nonprofit organization, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year in recurring funds to support Folkmoot USA's community international arts and cultural education programs which serve Western North Carolina.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
