5	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-81(b) reads as rewritten:			
6	"(b) The Basic Education Program shall include course requirements and descriptions			
7	similar in format to materials previously contained in the standard course of study and it shall

26	The State Board shall not adopt or enforce any rule that requires Algebra I as a graduation			
27	standard or as a requirement for a high school diploma for any student whose individualized			
28	education program (i) identifies the student as learning disabled in the area of mathematics and			
29	(ii) states that this learning disability will prevent the student from mastering Algebra I.			
30	The State Board shall not require a high school graduation project as a requirement for a			
31	high school diploma for any student."			
32	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
