CELEBRATION OF THE CITY OF NEW BERN.

Whereas, city, county, and private sources will contribute over 70% of the \$2.15 million in anniversary celebration funds; and

Whereas, it is imperative that the State ensure the continuing success of New Bern and its importance to North Carolina and the nation; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of New Bern the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated to the New Bern 300th Anniversary Committee to cover costs associated with planning, promoting, and implementing a yearlong program of events in New Bern, a statewide outreach program to North Carolina public schools, publications, and a series of travel programs to cities across North Carolina to engage North Carolinians in our State's history.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
