Short Title: Electors Holding Appointive Office. (Public) Sponsors: Senator Rand. Referred to: Judiciary I. March 25, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS MAY HOLD THAT OFFICE IN ADDITION TO THE NUMBER OF APPOINTIVE OFFICES ALLOWED BY LAW. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Article 18 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 163-209.2. Elector may be held in addition to other appointive offices. The office of elector may be held in addition to the maximum number of appointive offices allowed by G.S. 128-1.1." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
