6		<b>FION 1.(a)</b> Establishment and Purpose. – There is established the Legislative	
7		ion on Insurance Coverage for the Diagnosis and Treatment of Autism	
8	Spectrum Disord	lers (Commission). The purpose of the Commission is to study and assess the	
9	need for and the	merits of providing health insurance coverage for the diagnosis and treatment	
10	of autism spectrum disorders. In conducting the study, the Commission shall consider the		
11	following:		
12	(1)	Autism is the second most common developmental disability, occurring in	
13		up to one of every 150 children born.	
14	(2)	More than 50,000 North Carolina families are affected by autism spectrum	
15		disorders.	
16	(3)	Research shows that evidence-based autism treatments provide the best	
17		outcomes both for the individual with autism and for reducing long-term	
18		economic costs.	
19	(4)	Currently, most health benefit plans specifically exclude coverage for the	
20		diagnosis and treatment of autism spectrum disorders.	
21		<b>FION 1.(b)</b> Membership. – The Commission shall consist of 17 members, as	
22	follows:		
23	(1)	Six members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, four of	
24 25		whom shall be members of the Senate and two of whom shall be public	
25 26		members, as follows:	
20 27		a. A representative from an institution of higher education with expertise in the area of autism.	
27		b. A behavioral analyst who is certified by the behavioral analyst	
28 29		certification board with a specialization in the area of autism.	
30	(2)	Six members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, four	
31	(2)	of whom shall be members of the House of Representatives and two of	
32		whom shall be public members, as follows:

SEC	CTION 1.(c) Cochairs The President Pro Tempore of the	Senate and the
Speaker of the	House of Representatives shall each designate one member	of the General
Assembly as C	ommission cochair. Vacancies on the Commission shall be fil	led by the same
appointing auth	ority that made the initial appointment. A quorum of the Comm	nission shall be a
majority of its r	nembers.	
SEC	CTION 1.(d) Authority. – The Commission, while in the discha	rge of its duties,
may exercise all powers provided for under G.S. 120-19, 19.1, and 19.4. The Commission may		
meet at the joint call of the cochairs. The Commission may meet in the legislative building or		
the legislative office building and may contract for professional, clerical, or consultant services		
as provided und	ler G.S. 120-32.02.	
SEC	<b>CTION 1.(e)</b> Reports. – The Commission shall report in	ts findings and
recommendatio	ns to the 2010 Regular Session of the 2009 General Ass	embly upon its
